Acrylic Painting

Kids Acrylic

Delight in fresh, professional acrylic paints. Some historical artists who have painted with acrylics are Andy Warhol, Mark Rothko, and Helen Frankenthaler.

Clay

Get your hands dirty and sculpt with One Pound of Air Dry, Terracotta Clay. We provide specialty tools to help you create in the studio. Some historical artists who have sculpted with clay are Pablo Picasso, Elizabeth Fritsch, and Toshiko Takaezu.

Watercolor

Savor with a palette of raw, pigmented watercolors. Some historical artists who have painted with watercolor are Vincent van Gogh, J.M.W. Turner, and Elizabeth Murray.

Oil Pastel

Relish in a dish of thick and buttery pastels. Includes sixteen different colors to experiment with. Some historical artists who have explored oil pastels are Pierre-Auguste Renoir, Edgar Degas, and Rosalba Carriera.

Ink

Go with the flow of traditional painting with ink and water. (Also known in Chinese as "Sumi-e") Some historical artists who have painted with ink are Wu Guanzhong, Chen Chun, and Sesshū Tōyō.

Gouache

Known for being the in-between of watercolor and acrylic, relax with the softness of gouache. Some historical artists who have painted with gouache are Fidelia Bridges, Joseph Mallord William Turner, and Camille Pissarro.

Charcoal

Try one of the world's oldest, traditional mark making methods. Some historical artists who have drawn with charcoal are Leonardo de Vinci, Käthe Kollwitz, and Frank Auerbach.
